Gri was joined by John Evans, General Secretary, Trade Union Advisory Committee to the OECD, France; Ursula von der Leyen, Federal Minister of Labour and Social Affairs of Germany; B. G. Srinivas, Senior Vice-President and Member of the Executive Council, Infosys Technologies; and Danilo Turk, President of the Republic of Slovenia. The session was moderated by Daniel Gros, Director, Centre for European Policy Studies (CEPS), Belgium.

"The public sector has the responsibility to create an environment with a regulatory framework that provides flexibility in the way organizations structure their workforce and talent pipeline, yet the stability required for growth and for people to feel secure in their jobs and their homes," comments Gri. "In turn organizations need to develop a robust workforce strategy that not only forecasts their future talent needs, but also identifies existing and potential talent pools and considers how to tap into this potential using innovative solutions that are tailored to the needs of their business and to external factors. This will enable employers to harness the power of the individual to accelerate long term business and economic growth in the Human Age."

This is a challenging time for businesses and individuals alike. The world has experienced a series of epic shifts; the evolving demographic landscape, the rise of individual choice and the continuing pressure to do more with less are converging to impact economic growth in an increasingly volatile world — the Human Age. In this new and challenging landscape, employers have awakened to human potential, recognizing the power of having the right employees, in the right place and at the right time. Employers now realize that talent is more important than ever, but at the same time, have been burned by the recession and are reluctant to hire until they find the perfect fit.

Gri continues: "Although progress has been made in Europe, we still have a long way to go; employers are struggling to find the talent to meet their needs. The findings of our latest Talent Shortage Survey reveal that 26% of employers in the EMEA region are struggling to fill vacancies due to a lack of available talent. This points to an urgent need for businesses and governments to readdress their approach to attracting and retaining business critical talent. Cohesion between the public and private sectors is likely to be key, not only between interested parties within national borders, but across the entire region, as we move towards an increasingly global workforce."

Gri will be leading the ManpowerGroup delegation at the World Economic Forum in Vienna.
